Police: Miller said they are still having a few car issues. One vehicle is currently at Bud's being repaired, it is still under warranty.

Finance Director: Eyink said the cash position report and the tax report are in the packets. He said the skid loader that the village recently purchased arrived on Friday. It is in the back if anyone would like to see it. The purchase price was \$40,694 and the village received \$21,500 for trading in the old one. He also mentioned the need for a Finance Committee meeting to discuss some budget changes.

Village Manager: Thomas reminded everyone of the Spring Breakfast Forum hosted by the Mercer County Community Development Department on April 24th. Please let him know if you will be attending. He mentioned that Butler Township will be passing a resolution in the near future which will authorize him to apply for a sign grant. The grant will fund the replacement of stop signs and warning signs in the township and in the village. He said the plans for the salt storage building have been submitted to the state and that the radios for the water department are installed and working correctly.
