<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Bag 1</u></p> <p><u>Paper:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Newspaper - Catalogs - Magazines - Junk Mail - Office Paper - Paper Egg Cartons - Food Boxes - Cardboard- Big boxes must be broken down and tied together. Smaller boxes must be broken down and put in recycling bags. <p><i>**All paper products must be free from food containments.</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Non-Recyclable Items</u></p> <p><u>NO STYROFOAM of ANY KIND (including Styrofoam egg cartons)</u></p> <p><u>Paper:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NO Paper Plates or Paper Cups - NO Tissues, Napkins, Paper Towels - NO Messy Pizza Boxes or Wax Coated Boxes - NO Spiral Notebooks or Hardback Books - NO Multilayer Bags (dog food bags, etc.) <p><u>Glass:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NO Ceramics or Clay - NO Light Bulbs, Window Glass or Pyrex <p><u>Plastic:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NO Grocery Bags or Salt Bags - NO Cellophane or Plastic Wrapping - NO Disposable Diapers - NO Plastic Toys - NO Plastic Containers with #3, 4, 5, 6, or 7 - NO Ribbons or Bows
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Bag 2</u></p> <p><u>Aluminum:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cans - Clean Foil - Pie Pans <p><u>Glass:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Glass Bottles and Jars <p><u>Plastic:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Milk, Juice, and Water Jugs - Detergent Containers - #1 and #2 Plastics <p><u>Other:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Christmas Lights - Small Appliances (toasters, can openers) <p><i>**Please rinse out all containers and remove all caps.</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">For hazardous household waste; such as batteries, paint, etc.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Please call Carla at Mercer County Solid Waste: 419-586-3695</p>
