

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1772

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE THRESHOLD AMOUNT FOR MANDATORY COMPETITIVE BIDDING TO MATCH OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 9.17; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 4.05 (L) of the Village of Coldwater, Ohio, charter requires that the threshold amount for competitive bidding be set by ordinance of Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Coldwater, Mercer County, Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE

The Village Manager shall use the competitive process for all contracts exceeding Ohio Revised Code Section 9.17, unless the contract is made through any joint purchasing program including programs operated by the State of Ohio or any department thereof. All purchase contracts in excess of the threshold shall be approved by Council,

SECTION TWO

The Village Manager may enter contracts under the threshold without competitive bidding, however, said contract must comply with the provisions of Section 5.08 of the Village of Coldwater Charter.

SECTION THREE

The ordinance shall be reviewed by Council every two years.

SECTION FOUR

All legislation in conflict herewith, including but not limited to Charter Ordinance No. 1478 and No. 1682, be and the same hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


