

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

May 11, 2026

The Council of the Village of Coldwater held its regular meeting in the Village Council Chambers on May 11, 2026, with Mayor Doug Bertke presiding. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.

Roll call was responded to by: Buschur, Rutschilling, Bettinger, and Davis. Absent at the start of the meeting were Seitz and Niekamp. Also present were Village Manager Jason Eyink, Law Director Judy Koesters and Finance Director Dylan Schwieterman.

Invocation by Bettinger.

A motion was made by Bettinger, second by Buschur to approve the minutes from April 27, 2026. Roll call resulted in the following ayes: Buschur, Rutschilling, Bettinger, and Davis. Motion Carried.

Reports:

Police: Wynk reminded everyone that his department and the Kiwanis club will be hosting a bike safety day on May 17, 2026 from 11:00 am to 1:00 PM.

Finance: Schwieterman discussed the cash position and tax report. Income tax revenue in April was favorable by \$237,000 as compared to last April. The large increase is due to the 2024 tax return revenue last year was at 1% at the time versus this year we were at 1.5% for the 2025 tax returns. The Village will also be receiving a \$15,000 grant through the AARP Community Challenge Program. Those funds will be used for benches, picnic tables, bike racks, and trash cans. Those will go around the pickleball/basketball courts.

Manager: Eyink updated that all the curbs on Second Street have been poured. Also, Second Street south of Sycamore Street is now down to one lane for the next week. Repairs for northbound Second Street will start here in a week or so. The holes for Diamond 8 light pole bases should be drilled this week, and the poles should come this week. The swimming pool is currently getting filled with water as they begin to get the pool ready to open at the end of May.

Ordinance 1776: An ordinance accepting the Replat of Lot 1839 and Lot 1840 in Wenning Acres Seventh Addition, providing for the vacation of a certain easement, and declaring an effective date. Ordinance 1776 received its first reading.

Ordinance 1777: An ordinance to adopt a cybersecurity program and declaring an emergency. Ordinance 1777 received its first reading

Schwieterman explained the state requires the village to adopt a cybersecurity program by July 1. This will hopefully help to prevent future cyber-attacks and if there is a cyber-attack we must have a plan to respond. Schwieterman will coordinate with the IT consultant to make sure the village is compliant with the program.
