

## RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

July 24, 2017

The Council of the Village of Coldwater held its regular meeting in the Village Council Chambers on July 24, 2017, with Mayor Joe Knapschaefer presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

Roll call was responded to by: Schwieterman, Brunswick, Branch, Kessen, and Ahrens. Bertke was absent.

A motion was made by Branch, second by Brunswick to approve the minutes from the July 10, 2017 regular meeting. Roll call resulted in the following ayes: Schwieterman, Brunswick, Branch, Kessen and Ahrens. Motion Carried.

Reports:

Finance Director: Eyink said that the Ohio BWC has sent out approximately 1 billion in refunds to employers. The Village received their refund last week for \$15,000.

Manager/Engineer: Eric said the new cell tower is up. They still need to finish running electric to it, and the Village will be putting a fence up around the site. ODOT will start grinding State Route 118 and State Route 219 the week after the picnic. The paving will be completed shortly after that.

Mayor: Knapschaefer said he attended active shooter training at Parkway High School last week. It was sponsored by the Mercer County Sheriff's Department. The Coldwater Police Department is hoping to do a similar training in October.

Old Business:

Ordinance 1661: An Ordinance providing for the establishment of zoning for all of the incorporated area of Coldwater, Ohio, received its second reading.

Ordinance 1662: An Ordinance regulating abandoned and junk motor vehicles and vehicle parts within the Village of Coldwater, Ohio; establishing penalties; and declaring an effective date received its first reading.

Thomas mentioned he will be out of the office for the remainder of the week.


A reminder that the August 14, 2017 council meeting will be switched to August 7, 2017.


An Environmental Committee meeting was scheduled for August 7, 2017 at 6:00 PM.
